News from Viji Matthews with the Konda Tribe Foundation - "We have been going through some tough times during COVID situation. It has affected our work and hugely impacted our resources. Our translation work has been progressing, but the MTTS (translators) have gone back to the villages since the COVID cases here are increasing day by day, within 500 metres radius, there are about 100 cases now, yesterday, just 100 metres away there were 5 cases reported. Strict lock-down. But we are working hard to finish the translation ahead of schedule since we know its only God's Word that can bring HOPE into their hopelessness, which is increasing day by day. We are so thankful to you and the church leadership to stand in the gap helping us to move on with translation of God's precious WORD. Thank you for your kind support and continue to support us in prayer particularly Minie who is training other translation consultants remotely through video link ups.
